Virtual Instruction Issues:

On 4/16 the Governor announced that all schools will continue to be closed at least through Friday, May 15th.

This Monday, 4/20, we resume our virtual instruction following the normal instructional schedule.

New Kindergarten and Grade 1 paper packets were mailed out this past Wednesday. Don't have your students work the materials until directed by the teacher on the teacher's [webpage](#).

3rd Marking Period report cards will be posted on the Genesis Parent Portal this coming Wednesday, 4/22. Paper copies of the report cards will not be mailed home. We have parent emails for 98.6% of our students, but only 60% of our parents are signed into the Genesis Parent Portal. The Genesis Parent Portal is an online means to view students grades, attendance, and conduct. We will keep pushing for Genesis Parent Portal access to get to 100%.

As previously noted, the MP3 grade will be based on student work completed in school up to and including 3/13. Work done from 3/17 to 4/6, if it would have improved the MP3 grade, will be factored by the teacher into the MP4 grade.

Other Issues of Importance:

In person PK and K registration appointments for 2020-2021 have been canceled because the school buildings remain closed. New PK-K registration will be done online. A link will be posted on the main page of the District's website shortly. Filling out this information via the Genesis Registration Portal will allow a student to be considered for the preschool program and register for Kindergarten. Once schools reopen, we will reach out to set up an in person appointment to review information, as well as to collect copies of birth certificates, physicals, immunization records and four proofs of residency that were not previously uploaded.
