Restart and Reentry for 2020-2021:

Monmouth County continues in High Risk (Orange). Freehold Borough is Very High Risk (Red).

Our district remains on full virtual learning on a normal full day schedule in response to our significant community spread of COVID-19.

Our district facilities are ready for in-school hybrid learning, once we return to Moderate Risk (Yellow).

Early next month we will send out to parents/guardians three plans to consider on how we should proceed on in-school hybrid when we're back in Yellow. The survey will seek parent responses on their preference on which approach to follow. These plans, that are outlined in our Reentry Plan, are briefly described below:

-Level 4: 50% core instruction on alternating half days; related courses done virtually in afternoons and on days not in school. Virtual students follow the same schedule. This is the plan we were ready to implement last September and again this month before we had to cancel.

-Level 6: 80% core instruction for all students on four half days per week; related courses done virtually in afternoons and off day. Virtual students follow the same schedule.

-Level 7: 100% in-school instruction following normal schedule, including eating lunch in school. Virtual students follow the same schedule.

Our Reentry Committee is working the details of each of these plans. We will outline in more detail the scheduling scheme from the student's perspective, along with what can be considered the pros and cons of each approach. At the simplest level, the plans represent choices of getting more benefit for accepting more risk. We have never surveyed our parents/guardians and faculty with all the in-school plans available. Once we settle on one of these approaches, we will plan with that goal in mind and that will be the plan we move to once back to Yellow.

While we remain fully virtual, breakfast and lunch can be picked up in the rear of PAC or the rear of the Freehold Library.
