Restart and Reentry for 2020-2021:

Monmouth County and the State of New Jersey as a whole remains at High Risk (Orange). Local conditions in Freehold Borough are worse and we are at the Very High Risk (Red) level. We've had 200+ cases in the Boro over the past three weeks. For these reasons Freehold Borough schools are on full virtual learning and will remain so until the COVID-19 community spread reverts back to Moderate Risk (Yellow).

Our facilities are ready to reopen school. Next month we will have an updated survey to parents/guardians with several choices for restarting in-school hybrid instruction. We want to assess the latest preferences and focus on one approach to jump to when back in Yellow.
