

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The New Jersey Department of Education has notified all schools in New Jersey of generalized social media threats predicting school violence for tomorrow, Friday, December 17th. The New Jersey State Police, through their Regional Operations & Intelligence Center, have advised that they are unaware of any specific credible threats concerning schools in New Jersey. In addition I have been in contact with Chief Dispenza of the Freehold Borough Police Department and they too are unaware of any threats made toward the Freehold Borough Schools or any other schools in our area.

Given the media attention surrounding this online activity I wanted you to hear directly from me as it pertains to Freehold Borough. Our schools have a robust security infrastructure in place including both physical and technological measures. With that said, our best security resources remain students and families who alert us to any unusual activity that they see or hear, however harmless it may seem. In partnership with the Freehold Borough Police Department we promptly investigate any threats related to our schools.
