Restart and Reentry for 2020-2021:

We continue in district with all preparations to transition to in-school hybrid learning on Monday, March 1st.

Principals are working on revised student schedules for both in-school and virtual students to reflect the Level 6/80% Plan.

Each student (K-8), whether in-school or virtual, will engage in their core courses (ELA, Math, Science/Social Studies) for four days of the week. This will include a 4 hour, 10 minute in-school session and 1 hour afternoon online synchronous session. Virtual students will be online synchronous for the entire time.

Pre-K students do not have related courses so will attend school five days per week.

Each student will also have one full day a week online during which their Physical Education, Spanish, Art, Music and Technology (elementary) will be scheduled.

The district is finalizing plans to offer free COVID nasal PCR tests to all students and staff Feb 25-27. You will soon be receiving guidance on how to schedule your appointment time. We will do the testing in the PAC old gym.

Parents at FLC needing before/after care services should sign up as soon as possible. The YMCA needs 10 students per day to make their operation viable.
