Restart and Reentry for 2020-2021:

At the Board of Education meeting held last night, the Board approved returning to in-school hybrid instruction using the Level 6/80% plan and designating Monday, March 1, 2021 as the transition date. Correspondence is being prepared and translated now to be mailed home outlining this same information, along with more details.

The Level 6/80% plan will have in-school hybrid students coming to school for four half days per week for their core courses (ELA, Math, Science/Social Studies). On the afternoon of the day they are in school, they will have a remote online check in with their core teachers towards the end of the school day.

Each student will have one day a week where they will not be in school and will have all of their related courses online. Related courses are: Physical Education, Health, Art, Music, Spanish and Technology. Students will receive a new schedule outlining the day they will have their out of school day for related subjects and the times of these courses.

Principals will be stepping up home communication to review the many procedures that will be in place to carry out in-person hybrid instruction with the least amount of risk. Virtual students will get their breakfast/lunches from behind the Freehold Library. Once we're back to in-school learning we will no longer distribute breakfast/lunch in the rear of PAC.

Students returning to in-school hybrid learning will be required to follow the district's uniform standards of dress as outlined in the Student Handbook, which can be found under District Information on our website.

Principals will be working to get a signed form from all in-school parents acknowledging the health procedures on when to keep a student home because of sickness or quarantine.

The district will be setting up required special education busing, as well as the YMCA before/after care at FLC. The YMCA needs at least 10 students per day to make their operation viable. We will be sending out a flyer to sign up shortly.

21st Century will be operating and will be reaching out to parents on how they will operate after March 1st.

We are in the final stages of setting up a one-time service to offer COVID testing to our students and staff in the PAC gym before we open March 1st. Details will be out shortly.
