Restart and Reentry for 2020-2021:

The district will start in-school hybrid learning this Monday, March 1st.

We currently have 116 students who are designated for in-school learning on Monday but for whom no signed health screening and acknowledgement form is on file in the school office. There will be no exceptions. This form is required of all staff and students who are to be in school. If you have not previously submitted this form, you can do so online [here](#).

For students at FLC, there was insufficient parent interest to operate the YMCA before and after care program. We will continue to see if we can get enough interest to set up this service.

Tomorrow from 10am - 2pm is the final day for free voluntary COVID PCR testing in the PAC gym. Details and sign up [here](#)

On Monday parents/guardians of virtual students will pick up their breakfast/lunch at the Freehold Library, 8am-12pm, Monday, Wednesday, Friday.

Students in school will get their lunch grab-and-go, along with their next day's breakfast grab-and-go. If their next day is a virtual day, they will also grab-and-go an extra lunch. Following a virtual day, students can eat breakfast-before-the-bell at school.

We will have robust procedures in place to keep everyone safe, but we should expect that we may eventually have COVID positive cases detected in school. In those cases we will immediately contact trace and determine if any staff/student was within 6ft of the COVID positive person for more than 15 minutes over a 24 hour period. The school Principal will alert families of such cases. We will not distinguish whether the individual is a staff or student. I will give summaries of cases via these blasts and at Board meetings. As of today, as known to us, we have one individual in isolation due to being COVID positive and six individuals in quarantine due to being exposed to a COVID positive individual.
