Restart and Reentry for 2020-2021:

Our reentry survey to parents/guardians to determine preferences for when we transition to in-school learning closes today. Thank you to all who submitted an input.

Earlier this week the NJ Department of Health revised its recommendations for Local Health Departments as relates to K-12 schools. They made an important revision that removes a key concern in our ability to properly staff the buildings. Now districts no longer have to mandate a quarantine period based on close contact with an individual with COVID-like symptoms. However, the requirement to quarantine based on close contact with an individual who is COVID positive remains in place.

With the survey data in hand, next week the district Reentry Committee will formulate an approach of what in-school plan we will transition to and make that recommendation to the Board for approval at the February 1st BOE meeting. Additionally, with the change in rules by the NJ Department of Health on close contacts under High Risk Orange, we may also be in a position to initiate the three-week warning and set an expected date for the transition back to in-school learning. We will be out with more precise details after the February 1st BOE meeting.

We are actively engaged in setting up COVID vaccinations for the staff through our partnership with CentraState. We aim to have the first shots in early February.
