We have 10 school days remaining in this school year.

For our 8th graders:

- We will do a full virtual 8th grade graduation on Thursday, June 18th.
- After school ends on June 19th we will organize times to collect 8th grade computer devices and to give out awards and diplomas. It will be a drive up event in the rear of PAC.
- Live mini 8th grade graduation events will be scheduled to occur after July 6th consistent with the Governor's restrictions. We have to submit a plan and have approval from the Department of Education for these events.

For all returning students:

- All students will keep their district issued computer devices over the summer.
- Student personal belongings will be collected by them once students actually return to school.

Return to School:

We are awaiting guidance from the Governor and the Department of Education on the terms and conditions to return to school in September. We have been told that the guidance may come our way by the middle of this month.

Clearly any return to school will be accompanied with restrictions, possibly significant restrictions, as we move from where we are now until the day that we have a widely available vaccine and our society can return to normal. We know many are becoming restless and intolerant of these restrictions. But until such time that a vaccine is widely available, we will have to take a number of mitigation measures in school to ensure the safety of our students and staff. When the general outline of the reopening guidance is received, we will work with all our stakeholders to ensure our operational plan for returning to school is the best it can be.
