Restart and Reentry for 2020-2021:

The district successfully transitioned to in-school learning this past Monday. We have 45% of our students attending in person, 55% on full virtual. Parents desiring to switch their students from virtual to hybrid or hybrid to virtual should contact their building Principal.

This week we had one instance of detecting a COVID positive individual at PAE, and one instance at FLC. In each case the school community was notified generally, and those who had close contact with the individual were notified in particular. As of this writing district-wide, we have 8 individuals in isolation due to actually being COVID positive and 20 other individuals on quarantine due to exposure to a COVID positive person. None of the COVID positive cases have been linked to in-school transmission.
