Virtual Instruction/Support Issues - This School Year:

This past Friday was the end of Interim Reporting Period 4. IR4 reports will be available on the Genesis Parent Portal this coming Friday.

Per the Governor's executive order, we will remain on virtual instruction through the end of this school year.

Kindergarten and Grade 1 students should expect additional instructional materials coming in the mail to carry students through the end of this school year.

We are planning a virtual 8th grade graduation on June 18th.

Plans will soon be announced for 8th graders to pick up their personal belongings and to get their cap & gowns. We will then be looking for a photo in their cap & gown to use during the virtual graduation ceremony. A plan will be laid out to pick up diplomas and to return any district Chromebooks and other materials after the graduation. Details on these events will be sent to the 8th grade families directly from FIS.

All other returning students will keep their Chromebooks over the summer to use with the online work we will have available, and to be ready to continue with virtual instruction in September, if that turns out to be the case.

Returning students will collect their personal belongings when they return to school. They will have time with their 2019-2020 teacher and classmates for closure and to collect their things.

We will make special provisions for this year's 2nd graders who will be located at PAE in 3rd grade next year.

Awards certificates from this year will be given to the 8th graders when they get their diploma, and to all others when they return next school year.

Virtual orientations are being organized for next year's 6th graders, 3rd graders and Kindergarten/Pre-Kindergarten students.

Virtual Instruction/Support Issues - Summer 2020:

We are currently closed until further notice for in school instruction by the Governor, so we are planning on the 21st Century and Special Education Extended Year Program being held virtually this summer. We will not conduct the Title I program this summer unless we are allowed back to in school instruction.

We will quickly advise if there is any change to the guidance for schools about the terms and conditions for returning to in school instruction, either for the summer 2020 or the 2020-2021 school year.

Virtual Instruction/Support Issues - Next School Year 2020-2021:

For September we will be ready to return to school or stay on virtual instruction as guidance is received from the Governor.

Our returning students in their new grades 3 to 8 will retain their Chromebooks. Students in grades 1 and 2 will need to be issued their devices. Kindergarten and Pre-Kindergarten students will be issued iPads. The iPads need to be ordered and are not in district yet. We have the Chromebooks ready for grades 1 and 2.

We remain mindful of the financial issues in our state. We know that our final aid numbers will not be set for the coming school year until the end of September. Any cuts to the state aid already assigned to us will cause disruptions, which we will have to work through. We remain hopeful there will be no changes to our state aid.
