CentraState is offering a free, voluntary, COVID vaccination clinic to our current district students who are 12 years old and older. The clinic will be this Thursday, May 20th from 1pm-4pm in the Old PAC gym. It will be on a walk in basis, but students need to be escorted by their parent/guardian and have a signed consent form and medical screening form. All district students 12 y/o and older are eligible, whether attending school in-person or full virtual.

Restart and Reentry for 2020-2021:

At last night's BOE meeting the Board confirmed that the district intends to remain in its current configuration (five-day, half-day in-school with afternoon remote sessions) through the end of the 2020-2021 school year.

The district has 49.7% of students attending in-school, 50.3% full virtual.

The district currently has 4 individuals in isolation due to being COVID positive. 12 other individuals are in quarantine for being exposed to someone who was COVID positive.

There have been no known cases of in-school transmission of COVID since in-school sessions restarted March 1st. Our region is in Moderate Risk Yellow.
