We have 19 school days remaining in this school year.

Per the Governor's executive order currently in force, we remain on virtual instruction at least through the end of this school year and are on virtual instruction until further notice going forward.

We continue with plans for a virtual 8th grade graduation on Thursday, June 18th.

Other than 8th graders, all students will keep their district issued computer devices through the summer.

Returning students will collect their personal belongings and awards when they physically return to school.

Virtual orientations are being organized. Next year's 3rd graders will have orientation on Friday, 6/12/20; next year's 6th graders will have orientation on Wednesday, 6/17/20.

The Governor may be giving additional guidance on the operation of schools in the days and weeks ahead. We remain alert to such announcements and will advise when new guidance changes plans.

We are planning on the 21st Century and Special Education Extended Year Program being held virtually this summer starting July 6th.

For September we await official guidance on the terms and conditions that would allow us to return to school. No such guidance has been received to date.

This past Friday the state Treasurer issued a comprehensive report on state finances related to the impact of COVID19. It is a sobering document which you can read [here](#). Early indications are that our district will have \$1.4M less in state aid compared to what was promised in February and upon which we passed our final budget for 2020-2021 on May 4th. The Governor is scheduled to make a 2nd budget speech on August 25th, after which we will be given our final state aid numbers. These cuts are likely to be painful and will surely have an adverse impact on our operations going forward.
