Based on an analysis of current needs the District is in the process of bringing on additional support for students using federal funding including an additional district guidance counselor, registered nurse, technology technician, English as a Second Language teachers, and a speech therapist. The addition of these positions are to assist in supporting students as we continue to get back to the school routine. We are working to get these personnel in place as quickly as possible.

Parent conferences will be held November 17, 18, and 19. The parent conferences on the evening of November 17 will be held in person, on November 18 they will be held virtually in the evening, and on November 19 they will be in person in the afternoon. The November 18 conferences are to give those parents and guardians who want to participate in conferences virtually an option to do so. More information will be coming out from your child's school on how to make an appointment with your student's teacher on any of these three dates.

All indications are that the approval of the COVID vaccination for children ages 5-11 is imminent. For those families wanting to have their child vaccinated we plan on hosting vaccine clinics after school and/or on the weekends when this becomes available to us. When dates and times of these vaccine events become known we will communicate it out to the entire school community. All participation in any of these vaccine events is voluntary. There are currently 20 students in quarantine awaiting COVID test results. There have been no known cases of in school transmission.
