2. Winter Storm Emergency January 4, 2018  
Whereas the Governor of the State of New Jersey issued Executive Order No. 238 declaring a State of Emergency due to a winter storm and blizzard conditions, and

Whereas the accumulation of snow, ice, and temperatures necessitated the use of heavy snow clearing services and equipment at the Park Avenue Complex and Freehold Learning Center in order to ensure the timely and safe reopening of school,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Freehold Borough Board of Education acknowledge that the School Business Administrator issued an emergency contract to All Green Lawn & Landscaping for the removal of snow and ice control of school property at the Park Avenue Complex in the amount of three thousand five hundred and seventy dollars (\$3,570.00) and Freehold Learning Center in the amount of six thousand seven hundred and fifty five dollars (\$6,755.00).
