1. Rejection of Bids

Whereas on March 16, 2019 the Assistant Superintendent for Business caused notice to be published in the Asbury Park Press soliciting bids in accordance with the Board architect's specifications for general construction work, plumbing; heating, ventilation, & air conditioning; electrical work; and a combined single overall contract in connection with the Park Avenue Elementary 5th grade wing HVAC replacement, Park Avenue Complex maintenance garage, Freehold Learning Center HVAC ductwork renovations, and Freehold Learning Center emergency generator, and
